Basic booking conditions

Booking

Requested dates will be held for 7 days. Within this time we must receive:

- a completed booking form
- a signed agreement
- a non-refundable booking deposit

Payments

We require a 20% deposit at the time of booking and the remaining balance 60 days before arrival date.

Full payment is required at time of booking for all reservations made within 60 days of arrival date.

We will confirm amounts and arrange payments via bank transfer.

Damage deposit

There is a refundable security deposit of £1,500 on all bookings. This must be paid in full via bank transfer with the final balance payment. This will be refunded in full following a damage inspection on departure (subject to our detailed terms and conditions).

Tax de sejour

This is a government tax on all tourist accommodation in France, collected by local government. The charge is 0.50 euros per person per night for all those over 18. We will calculate the total cost of this tax for your stay and we'll collect this in cash from you on arrival.

Agreement

You will be provided with detailed terms and conditions when you make a booking. And you will be asked to sign a contract/agreement, which protects both parties. This is all done in a simple electronic process.

We will also ask for ID from guests at the time of booking that is not shared with any other party.

Other useful information

- Linen, bath towels and pool towels are provided for your stay. If your stay is longer than a week these will be changed at a time that is convenient with you. We can arrange further cleaning and changes if required at an additional

charge.

- Private parking is included within the grounds of the villa.
- Free WiFi is available.
- Refreshments will be available on arrival.
- Additional services can be provided from in-villa breakfast to the hire of a personal chef. We will send you further details of these separately.
- No smoking is permitted inside the property and no pets are allowed on the premises.
- One cot is available in addition to the maximum occupancy stated on the website.
