Terms and Conditions

Reservations

Whilst every effort will be made to hold a provisional booking, a booking can only be considered as confirmed once we have received a completed booking form together with the appropriate deposit, and the client subsequently receives written confirmation from us.

Payment

A non-refundable deposit of £200 per mobile home is required at the time of booking, with the balance due not less than 9 weeks before the commencement of the rental period. Payments for bookings made less than 9 weeks before the commencement of the rental period will be required in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation

Cancellations must be notified in writing. If the client wishes to cancel a previously confirmed booking more than 9 weeks before the commencement of the rental period, the non-refundable deposit will be retained; all other payments will be refunded. If the cancellation occurs less than 9 weeks before the commencement of the rental period no refund will be possible unless we are able to relet the accommodation for the cancelled period, any expenses incurred in doing so will be deducted. If in the unlikely event we require to cancel the booking, a full refund will be made.

We recommend that you take out appropriate holiday insurance including cancellation cover.

The Campsite

Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that the campsite facilities/services described in our information is accurate, it should be understood that the implementation or withdrawal of any such facility/service is entirely at the discretion of the campsite owners/management and is therefore outside our control.

Please note that in low season, the use of some facilities may be restricted.

Similarly, we would be unable to accept responsibility for any other event outside our control which may affect the quality of your holiday.

The client agrees on behalf of all party members to abide by the prevailing rules and regulations of the campsite. If as a result of a failure to observe the site regulations, or if in the opinion of the campsite owners/management, a party member behaves in an unsuitable or improper manner and is subsequently asked to leave, we are unable to accept any liability or offer any refund.

The Accommodation

The client agrees on behalf of all party members to take all reasonable care of the accommodation and its contents during the rental period and to leave the mobile home(s) and equipment in a **clean** and tidy condition before departure so that it is ready for immediate occupation. If, in our opinion, the accommodation has been left in an unsatisfactory condition, a cleaning charge of £40 per hour will be payable.

Any variations from the inventory should be reported to our representative on the first day of the rental period.

No-Smoking Policy

In the interests of safety, and the comfort and enjoyment of both the owners and clients, we would ask that all clients kindly refrain from smoking inside our mobile homes.

Security/Cleaning Deposit

Where applicable a refundable security deposit of £200 per mobile home is payable with the final remittance. We reserve the right to deduct from this deposit the cost of any losses/breakages/damage which may occur during the rental period, together with any additional cleaning charges resulting from the accommodation being vacated in an unreasonable condition. In normal circumstances, assuming no deductions are required, the deposit will be returned to you by cheque/PayPal within 21 days of the end of the rental period.

Cycle waiver

ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER

The bicycles provided at the homes are NOT serviced or repaired in line with the standards you would expect from a hire cycle, the reasons for this waiver is the cycles are the owners personal cycles which are not included in the holiday rental, should I choose to use them I accept the conditions detailed in the waiver.

Assumption of Risk: I understand and accept that by choosing to use the personal (non rental) bicycles and participating in biking exposes me to many hazards and entail risks including but not limited to death, personal injury (including but not limited to severe spinal or head injury) and loss of or damage to property. I also understand I should be in good physical health to participate in bicycling. I choose to participate in bicycling in spite of these risks and hereby assume all

risk of injury or loss of life to myself and loss of or damage to property arising out of using this bicycle and participating in bicycling. I understand the inherent risk involved in using this equipment, accept full responsibility for any and all such damage or injury which may result. Waiver And Release: In consideration of choosing to use this bicycle, I specifically release and forever discharge Peter and Catherine Bridge and Their affiliates, officers, agents, and employees from any and all liability or claims for injury, illness, death or loss of or damage to property which I may suffer while using this bicycle and participating in bicycling. This discharge specifically includes, but is not limited to, liability or claims for injury, illness, death or damage caused by the negligence of the owner or its affiliates, officers, agents, or employees. It is my intent by the Waiver And Release Agreement to release the owner and hold it harmless from all liability for any such property loss or damage, personal injury or loss of life, whether caused by the negligence of the owner or whether based upon breach of contract, breach of warranty, or any other legal theory. In signing this document, I fully recognize that if injury, illness, death or damage occurs to me while I am engaged in using this bicycle or participating in bicycling, I will have no right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against the owner or its affiliates, officers, agents or employees, even if they or any of them negligently cause my injury, illness, death or damage.

General Information

Arrival

We would normally expect guests to arrive between 4pm and 6pm. However, if you have told us that you intend to arrive earlier than 4pm, we will always do our best to try to make sure that your accommodation is ready for you as early as possible. In any event you will be able to use the campsite facilities as soon as you arrive.

Our representatives Paul and Lynn will meet you on arrival and be available on-site during your stay. If necessary they can be contacted on their French mobile phone number: **0642134157** If calling from UK phone drop the 0 and add 00 33

If you are delayed significantly en route it would be helpful if you could contact the onsite reps particularly if you are going to be later than 7pm. If necessary, alternative arrangements can then be made to collect the keys to your mobile home.

On arrival at the campsite, please go through the entrance barrier which should open automatically as you approach it (providing you have advised us of your vehicle reg number as it has number plate recognition).

(The barrier is normally closed between 11pm and 7am to prevent any unnecessary traffic noise at night).

Turn right, after passing the pool on your right, the third plot on the LEFT is signposted Venez Vendee reception.

Departure

Guests are expected to vacate their mobile home by 11am and to **ensure that the accommodation is left clean and tidy**, ready for our representatives to check the mobile home for the next guests.

What to Take

Our mobile homes are well equipped - other than your own towels and personal effects, you should really only need to

take tea towels with you. You might also find it useful to take a small towel or bath mat for use in the shower room as the floor can become slippery when wet. It would be advisable to take your own travel adapter.

Insects (including mosquitoes) can sometimes be a nuisance during the evenings, and although suitable repellents can be bought at the campsite or in the local supermarkets you may prefer to take your own with you.

Bed Linen

Duvets and pillows are provided as standard, however bed linen i.e. fitted sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers are required.

If you take sleeping bags, you will still need pillow cases and sheets.

In the interests of hygiene, the duvets, pillows and mattresses must not be used without suitable covers

Smoking

We would kindly request that guests do not smoke inside the mobile home. An ash tray is provided for outside use only.

Swimming

There is a general rule in France that men/boys should wear proper swimming trunks and not loose fitting swim shorts or Bermuda type shorts in swimming pools. Enforcement of this rule can vary but we would suggest that you bring appropriate swimwear with you or perhaps be prepared to buy locally if necessary.
